### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. The Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA) is an independent organisation that was established by the Labour Relations Act of 1995 (LRA) to deliver dispute prevention and resolution services to the people of South Africa. The core mandate of the CCMA, as one of the organisations charged with implementing the LRA, is derived from the purpose of the LRA which, amongst others, is to advance economic development, social justice, labour peace and the democratisation of the workplace.

### 2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2.1. The overarching strategic function of the CCMA's Business Research Intelligence Sub-Unit within the Business Research Intelligence and Communications (BRICS) Unit reporting under the Governance and Strategy Department is to conduct robust business research to ensure the production of reliable and valid information for both strategic and operational decision-making purposes. The Sub-Unit makes use of cutting-edge research and evaluation methodologies to ensure excellent service delivery to internal and external consumers of research information and intelligence. A critical aspect of ensuring that quality data is availed to the vast array of audiences includes the utilisation of appropriate qualitative data analysis software. As such, the services of a service provider to provide for the deployment or provision of a qualitative data analysis software is required.

### 3. OBJECTIVE

3.1 The CCMA requires a service provider to supply a software package that will be used for qualitative data management, the analysis thereof and the presentation of the qualitative data or themes arising. The CCMA invites quotations from reputable and competent service providers for the provision of such a software for a period of thirty-six (36) months for the use of four (4) Researchers including the Unit's manager.

### SCOPE OF WORK

4.1This is an RFQ for an electronic qualitative data analysis software. The software licence must permit at least 4 users to use it simultaneously. **Functionality** must include the following:

- 1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.
- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "B-BBEE" means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (b) "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) "functionality" means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
